Transfer to the Kamakura, visit the Great Buddha, a bronze statue of Amida Buddha and the second tallest bronze Buddha statue in Japan. Then, go to Enoshima, which is known for its Pacific Ocean beaches and attractions. Afterwards, enjoy your time in Yokohama China Town and Yokohama Akarenga. Later on, back to Tokyo and have a good time in Shibuya, one of Tokyo's most popular neighborhoods.

Then, visit the famous Nijubashi Bridge, which is outside of the Imperial Palace outer gardens. Later, head for Shinjuku Kabukicho. Finally, transfer to Hot Spring Hotel near Mt. Fuji Area and enjoy Japanese-Style hot spring and dinner.

Then go to Bussharito Heiwa Park to appreciate the gardening featured with Japanese characteristics. Later, transfer to Nagoya and stroll on the famous Osu Shopping District. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

It is a good place to experience the ancient charm and culture of Kyoto. The Yasaka Shrine is almost always buzzing with energy, with eager devotees flocking to receive blessings and pray for good fortune. Walk on Hanamachi Street, the most stylish geisha district in Japan from the Edo period. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

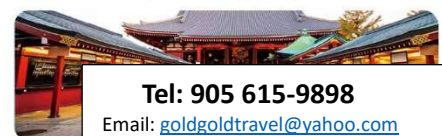

PASSPORTS & VISA

Passengers are responsible for all visas, entry, health and other requirements and documents required by law, regulations, orders and/or requirements of countries visiting. All passengers travelling abroad require a passport, valid for 6 months beyond the conclusion of their trip, and with appropriate visas. Multiple-entry visas are required for some countries. It is the responsibility of each passenger to have a valid passport and the necessary visas, as well as to comply with entry, health or other requirements of the countries visiting. The operator and/or its agents are not responsible for passport, visa requirements, entry, health, or other requirement of the countries visited or for any loss sustained by passengers for failing to comply with laws, regulations, order and/or requirements of countries visited.

RESERVATION AND PAYMENT

A deposit of US\$500 per person is required to reserve space on the tour. The balance is due 45 days prior to departure. We reserved the right to cancel the reservation should payments not be received within the above specified periods, and all payment previously made will not be refunded under this circumstance. Only cash, bank draft or certified cheque will be accepted for any payment made within 30 days of tour departure, personal cheque will not be accepted.

CANCELLATIONS PENALTIES

Notice of cancellation must be made in writing to Gold-Gold Travel and the following scale of cancellation fees will be applied.

- Over 45 days prior to departure will incur a penalty of US\$500 per person.
- From 31 - 44 days prior to departure will incur a penalty of US\$900 per person.
- If the tour is cancelled within 21-30 days before departure, 75% of the total tour fee will be deducted from the tour fee per person.
- Within 20 Working days prior to departure or withdrawal from a tour, will regard forfeiting the tour on own, no tour fee will be refunded.
